The project's public involvement program includes multiple opportunities for the public to participate by submitting comments, attending public meetings hosted by Idaho Power, the BLM and/or the ODOE-EFSC and keeping informed through project materials such as the project Web site (www.boardmantohemingway.com) and newsletters. We encourage your participation and welcome your comments and questions about the project.

- Idaho Power's Community Advisory Process
 - Idaho Power will continue to work with members of the PATs as part of the CAP during the NEPA and ODOE-EFSC processes
- National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Process
 - The public will have the opportunity to provide comments to the BLM upon submittal of Idaho Power's amended right-of-way application (SF-299) and later on the Draft EIS
- ODOE-EFSC Process
 - The public will have the opportunity to provide comments to the ODOE upon submittal of Idaho Power's amended Notice of Intent and later on the Draft Proposed Order
